How Visual Studio assigns solution configurations When you create a project configuration (in the Configuration Manager , by choosing New on the drop-down menu in the Configuration column for that project) and select the Create new solution configurations check box, Visual Studio looks for a like-named solution configuration to build the project on each platform it supports.

Visual Studio will then perform the selected action for all selected projects, configurations, and platforms. Proceed with Caution. As I've mentioned above, you can quickly create a confusing set of build configurations when the names don't match between project configurations and solution configurations.

### Understanding the .NET Build Configuration System - SubMain

The solution is simple: 1. In Visual Studio, click the Build > Configuration Manager menu item. 2. In the Configuration Manager window, be sure the Build box is checked for each project. You will likely want to do this for both the Debug and Release configurations, as selected in the Active solution configuration drop-down.

### Project is not selected for building in solution ...

Here's a workaround if already checked the Create new solution configurations checkbox: Open Explorer and navigate to the location of the solution for the project that is missing platforms. Move the solution .sln file to a temporary location where Visual Studio won't locate it. Open the .csproj file for the project that is missing platforms.

If you want all projects under the solution build in release mode, there are two ways to implement your requirement. First way, build your solution with MSBuild and use the command of "/p:Configuration=Release", which will build your solution in release mode. Please refer to:

### **How to set a default configuration in a Visual Studio ...**

To enable this, Visual Studio .NET allows projects and solutions to have a number of different configurations. Each configuration can specify its own settings for any property of any project. By default, Visual Studio .NET creates Debug and Release configurations for all projects and solutions.
